

Wooster Country Club Pool

Pool rules are employed for the safety and well-being of all swimmers and will be posted at the pool. Failure to comply with pool rules may result in the suspension of pool privileges. The Pool Guard Manager is responsible for the enforcement of these rules and for reporting any violations to the General Manager.

Pool/Snack Shop Hours & Guidelines

- Mondays - Sundays 11:00 pm - 6:00 pm.
 - Cabana Service will be available Tuesday – Saturday 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm
 - Sundays ~ 12:00 pm – 3:00 pm
 - Mondays ~ No Service from the Clubhouse
- All members and guests must sign the pool register before entering the pool. Guest fees: Local or Out-of-Town are \$10.00 per person per day. All guests must be accompanied by a member. Married children of members are considered guests.
- Outside Food & Beverages are strictly prohibited from being brought onto the grounds.
- Local ADULT guests (18 & over) within Wooster City limits are not permitted to use the pool facilities more than five (5) times per season. However, Minor guests (17 & under) are permitted unlimited guest visits when accompanied by a member.
- Non-member babysitters / nannies may be a member's guest more than five (5) times per season as long as the member children are present. Prior authorization from the General Manager is required.
- Babysitters / nannies are not permitted to bring their own guests or use the pool without the member present.

Swim Attire

- Swimming attire is one or two-piece suits for women and trunks for men. Infants in the pool need only to wear trunks or suitable coverings.
- A swim robe and sandals should be worn by adults outside of the pool area and by anyone planning to enter the Clubhouse.

Swim Bathhouse

- The Club or Staff will not be responsible for lost or stolen items at the pool.
- No smoking of any kind will be permitted anywhere inside the gated area of the pool. If you must smoke, you are required to do so at least 100 feet from either entrance area.
- No food or beverage is permitted to be brought into the pool area.

Pool

- The whistle will be used only when necessary to gain the attention of the swimmer.
- Non-swimmers must remain in shallow water areas. To be permitted in deep water areas, a swimmer must be able to swim the pool width with ease. ***If a child is unable to swim and requires the use of arm floaties or other floating devices, they will not be permitted in the deep well of the pool at any time!***
- Chewing gum in the pool area is not permitted.
- Jumping, diving or general horseplay around other swimmers is not permitted.
- Swim and play equipment will be permitted with special permission of the Pool Manager and within the Manager's guidelines. ***NO SQUIRT GUNS!***

- Rest breaks are 15 minutes every 1 hour & 45 minutes. Adults (18 and older) only will be permitted in the pool during rest breaks. Swim times will be;
 - 10:30 – 11:00 (***Adult Lap Swim ONLY***)
 - 11:00 – 1:00
 - 1:15 – 3:00
 - 3:15 – 5:00
 - 5:15 – 7:00

Pool Discipline & Procedures

- ***All children 12 years old or younger will be required to take a swimming test before they will be allowed in the deep end of the pool or off of the diving board. This test will consist of swimming one lap of the pool and treading water for 30 seconds. There are NO exceptions to this rule! Floating devices such as armbands or waistbands DO NOT count!***
- No child under the age of 10 are permitted at the pool without an adult or responsible person supervising. **LIFEGUARDS DO NOT COUNT!**
- The Pool Manager and Lifeguards have the authority to control the conduct and activities of persons in the pool area. Guards will follow the procedures of warning the swimmer and benching the swimmer from the pool for the first rule of infraction. If violations of the rules continue, the swimmer will be suspended and the parents notified.
- Lifeguards have the authority to forgo the usual warnings, and bench/suspend the swimmer from the pool immediately, if the situation warrants this decision.
- Suspensions of more than one day shall be recorded and kept by the Pool Manager. This record shall include: name, dates of suspension, date of return, which rules were broken, and the name of the lifeguard handling the situation.
- Three suspensions in one season will be grounds for expulsion for the remainder of the year.

Swim Desk (Grass & Concrete Areas)

- No running.
- No glass containers of any kind.
- No Eating or drinking in the pool. Smoking is permitted only in designated areas 100' outside the fencing.
- Unnecessary distractions or conversations with lifeguard on duty will not be permitted.
- Pushing or pulling others into the pool is not permitted.
- Snapping towels, spitting, pinching or other horseplay is not permitted.
- A maximum of two running steps will be permitted when jumping or diving into the pool.
- Swimmers should be facing the water when jumping or diving into the pool.
- The use of pool furniture will be for adults first, and then children as available.
- Members are responsible for cleaning up the areas they occupy.
